



Code of Ethics

Leadership has an obligation to do more than just meet legal standards, members are expected to meet moral standards of conduct as well. Below is the code of ethics that the Home Builders Association of Southwest Colorado (HBASC) Members will be held accountable for.

HBASC Members are required to:

1. Conduct all business in a manner reflecting honor and integrity. We rely heavily on our solid reputation for honesty, fairness and ethical conduct. That reputation ultimately rests on the good judgment and personal integrity of everyone, especially our members considering becoming directors.
2. Maintain the highest standard of personal conduct, avoiding even the perception of improper conduct, using only legal and ethical means in all activities including conducting all financial transactions in a responsible manner.
3. Represent the interests of all people served by the association, and not favor any special interests inside or outside of the association.
4. Not use service on the board for own personal advantage or for the advantage of friends or supporters.
